

Treats Arts and Fun Stuff to Do

Located in the heart of Franken (Franconia), Ansbach and the area that surrounds it offer numerous leisure activities and fun places such as amusement parks, historical sites and museums, zoos and animal parks, shopping malls, and restaurants. This list of "Fun Stuff Off Post" is not a complete list of places as there are too many, but shows some of the more popular locations.



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Zoos and Animal Parks

Tiergarten Nürnberg – Nürnberg Zoo

Highlights: The Tiergarten Nürnberg features a Delphinarium with an outdoor Laguna for dolphins and sea lions (four shows daily), an Aqua Park for beavers, otters, penguins, seals and polar bears, as well as a manatee house. With more than 2,000 animals of 300 species from all over the world, a children's zoo and a large playground it is one of Europe's largest zoos. The landscaping is mainly forest paths, with meadow areas and ponds built into a former sandstone quarry.

Opening Times:

April – October – daily 8 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. November – March – daily 9 a.m. – 6 p.m.

Admission Prices:

Adults 13.50 €, children 6.50 €, family ticket (1 parent + minor children) 18 €, family ticket (2 parents + minor children) 31.50 €



Wildpark an den Eichen in Schweinfurt

Highlights: The wildlife park houses 500 animals from Germany and other countries, mostly hoofed animals like moose and deer, as well as wild boars and lynxes. Smaller animals like guinea pigs can be admired in the petting zoo. A kiddy pool refreshes the little ones in summer; playgrounds are spread out in the park. Signs and brochures are available in English.

A tavern is open every afternoon in summer and on weekends in winter. A putt-putt facility is open every afternoon from April to October.

Highlights: The wild horse park is located on the former US training area near Tennenlohe; the animals were returned to the wild to regenerate their kind and to keep the biotope from reforesting; there is no opportunity to pet or feed them, but the patient visitor may spot them in their natural environment from the look-out hill.

Highlights: Although there are no action rides in this park, there are plenty of hands-on activities waiting for creative minds. A gigantic tree house towers above to be climbed by the brave, a pirate ship can be boarded with the help of log rafts, and a knight's castle is waiting to be conquered. Miniature golf and a balancing course help get rid of some of that extra energy.

Opening hours: Times vary according to season; the outdoor section is closed during the winter season.

Admission Prices: Ticket prices range from 5 € to 11 €, depending on the season.



A fairy tale forest, water slides and much more are gathered around the historical moated castle. There are also wild west stunt shows, knights' tournaments and playgrounds, a petting zoo, and restaurants.

Opening hours: Opening time is always 10 a.m., closing times vary with the season; closed in winter.

Tickets for adults are 16 €, 14 € for children; senior discount, family and season tickets are available.


Highlights: The Imperial Castle, symbol of Nürnberg, rises high above the city. The castle, where between 1050 and 1571 all Emperors of the Holy Roman Empire of the German Nation resided at least some of the time, is one of the most important imperial palaces of the Middle Ages. The Palas (main building) with its sumptuously furnished Emperor's rooms, the Roman double chapel, the deep well, and the Sinwell Tower,

as well as a comprehensive collection of weapons and utensils can be visited today. Audio guides are available in English for the Palas.

Opening Hours:

Daily (except Christmas and New Year's): April to September: 9 a.m. – 6 p.m. October to March: 10 a.m. – 4 p.m.

Admission: € 7 regular admission, children enter for free; various group rates available



Germanisches Nationalmuseum

Highlights: The Germanisches Nationalmuseum is one of Europe's largest and greatest museums concerning the history of civilization; the chronological spectrum of the Germanisches Nationalmuseum extends all the way to the present. Of particular appeal to visitors of all ages are the imposing suits of armor in the collection of historical weapons and armor, the toy collection with its rare and wonderful doll houses and one of the world's foremost collections of historical musical instruments.

Highlights: "Back to Dürer" – this is the motto of Albrecht Dürer's House, presenting the living and working quarters of the great artist, Albrecht Dürer (1471–1528).

The museum shows all facets of Dürer and his work. In the screening room, the multi vision show "Albertus Durer Noricus" allows a unique novel view of Dürer's work. Guided tours in English take place at 2 p.m. every Saturday.

Nürnberg Dungeons

Highlights: Just a few steps away from the main market square, vaulted cellars below the splendid city hall built in Nürnberg's golden age accommodate the medieval dungeons.

They were established as early as the 14th century and were not prisons as we know them today, but were used mainly for prisoners awaiting trial and for convicted criminals awaiting execution of their judgment. Twelve small cells and one larger one, a torture chamber called "Chapel" because of its dimensions, paint a depressing picture of the gruesome practices of justice in former times.

The dungeons may only be visited on a guided tour in German (about 20 minutes). It is not advised for children under ten years of age.

Toy Museum

Highlights: Nürnberg has always been a toy city of world renown, its tradition stretching from the "Dockenmacher" (doll makers) of medieval times to outstanding tin figure manufacturers and numerous tin toy producers in the industrial age up to the International Toy Fair, the world's most important trade fair of its kind.

Nürnberg's Toy Museum in the very heart of the Old Town is part of this rich cultural heritage. Its comprehensive and exceptionally high quality collection spans the time from antiquity to the present day, with a strong focus on the past two centuries.

DB Museum im Verkehrsmuseum (German Railway Museum)

Highlights: The DB Museum, opened in 1899 as Royal Bavarian Railway Museum, is Germany's oldest railway museum. Today, as museum of the Deutsche Bahn AG, together with the Museum of Communication, it forms the Nürnberg Traffic Museum. Exhibits include about 40 historic rail vehicles, among them the legendary "Adler" (Eagle) locomotive. In addition to numerous special exhibitions and events, the museum's main attraction is the "Experience Area" of 1,000 square meters.

Memorium Nuremberg Trials

Highlights: The Memorium explains the historical events before and during the trials as well as the juristic prosecution of Nazi crimes. The actual trial room is still in use, but can be toured if court is not in session.

Documentation Center Nazi Party Rally Grounds

Highlights: To this day, in Nürnberg's southern districts, the remains of the buildings on the former Nazi Party Rally Grounds with their immense proportions are a vivid testimony to the megalomania of the National Socialist regime. This area of eleven square kilometers was intended as an impressive backdrop for the Nazi party rallies staged here to demonstrate their power.

The Documentation Centre Nazi Party Rally Grounds, often shortened to Dokuzentrum (Docu Center), is located in the north wing of the Congress Hall, designed by the National Socialists to house 50,000 spectators, remained unfinished, though. With its "glass and steel arrow," piercing the north wing, the Documentation Centre is a widely visible architectural counterpoint. It focuses on the topics which have a direct link to Nürnberg, and is centered on 19 exhibition areas which are structured in chronological order: the history of the party rallies, the buildings of the Nazi Party Rally Grounds, the "Nürnberg Racial Laws" of 1935, the "Nürnberg Trials" of the main perpetrators of

Nazi crimes in 1945/46 and the twelve follow-up trials, as well as the difficult problem of dealing with the National Socialists' architectural heritage after 1945.

Highlights: The open air museum features approximately 100 rebuilt old Franconian houses, which are separated in different groups and time zones, located along small roads and fields. An herbal pharmacy and
