Command Sergeant Major Matthew D. McCoy assumed responsibility as the Command Sergeant Major for the U.S. Army Communications-Electronics Command (CECOM) on February 16, 2016.

Command Sergeant Major Matthew D. McCoy was born in Port Jefferson, New York. He entered the United States Army in June 1992 after earning his high school diploma from East Lake High School in Tarpon Springs, Florida.
