## CNATRA NOTICE 1542

Subj: MULTI-ENGINE T-44A GPS GRADED ITEMS

Ref: (a) CNATRAINST 1542.147F

(b) CNATRAINST 1542.153C

- 1. Action. Effective immediately, if a Student Military Aviator (SMA) or Instructor Under Training (IUT) reaches the end of a training block in references (a) or (b) where "RNAV/GPS Approach" or "FMS Operation" is a required graded item, and the SMA or IUT has not received a grade on either item, the Instructor Pilot (IP) shall mark the item on the Aviation Training Form with the respective Maneuver Item File grade. The IP shall annotate in the remarks section: "RNAV/GPS Approach/FMS Operation not conducted on this event, but graded in accordance CNATRA NOTICE 1542." A copy of this Notice shall be placed in all T-44A SMA and IUT Aviation Training Jackets.
- 2. <u>Scope</u>. To the maximum extent possible, training in the "RNAV/GPS Approaches" and "FMS Operations" Course Training Standard References will continue until precluded by equipment obsolescence.
- 3. <u>Point of Contact</u>. Point of contact for this Notice is the CNATRA Multi-Engine Pipeline Training Officer (N713) at DSN 861-3654, COMM (361) 961-3654.
- 4. <u>Cancellation Contingency</u>. This Notice shall remain in effect for one year unless cancelled by CNATRA or superseded by a CNATRA Notice on the same subject.
