Subj: TEST PILOT SCHOOL (TPS) T-6B CURRICULUM AT TRAINING AIR WING FIVE

1. <u>Purpose</u>. This notice directs utilization of reference (a), as modified below, in the training of Test Pilot School candidates at Training Air Wing FIVE.

2. <u>Syllabus Description</u>. This syllabus is designed to provide TPS candidates with the initial ground, simulator, and flight training required for completion of an initial T-6B NATOPS qualification. The initial NATOPS check flight will not be completed at Training Air Wing FIVE.

3. <u>Course Data</u>. Utilize reference (a) with Course ID Number (CIN): Q-2A-0165; Course Data Processing Code (CDP): 13T7 (TW-5) for this TPS candidate training.

a. Due to the unique nature and time constraints of this course, the Time-to-Train (TTT) calculations contained in reference (b) are modified and will affect this syllabus only. Training days corrected for weather (Tw) shall be rounded up to the nearest whole day.

b. Course Length: 17.0 Training Days, 23.0 Calendar Days,3.3 Calendar Weeks.

c. Course Hours: 3.0 (Administration), 55.0 (Ground Training), 1.5 (Flight Support), 6.5 (Simulator), 12.4 (Aircraft).

## 4. Event List

a. To meet this requirement, the following events contained in reference (a) shall constitute the course of instruction for the TPS T-6B Curriculum: G0101-2, G0104-6, G0111, G0201, SY0101-16, SY0190, SY0201-12, SY0290, SY0301-2, Q1101, Q2101, Q2103, Q3101, Q3201-2, Q4101-3, Q4201, Q4203-4, F4101.

b. Those events not listed above in the Primary Flight Instructor Pilot Training (PFIT) Course flow will be administratively waived in order to complete the TPS T-6B curriculum.

c. Events not completed may be waived by the TPS Chief Flight Instructor.

## 5. Grading and MIF

a. TPS candidates must receive a passing grade on all academic tests to proceed. TPS candidates are required to meet EOB MIF on Q2103, Q3101, Q3202, and Q4103. TPS candidates are required to meet MIF on Q4204, with the exception of Course Rules, which will have a MIF of "3".

b. For event F4101, TPS candidates shall meet MIF of "3+" on General Knowledge/Procedures. All remaining items on F4101 will be demonstrated by the Instructor Pilot, may be attempted by the TPS candidate, and will receive a MIF of "1" regardless of performance.

6. <u>Syllabus Notes and Restrictions</u>. F4101 is highly desired, but is optional depending on scheduling within the TTT.

7. <u>Unsatisfactory Performance</u>. This syllabus is designed to the same standards as the T-6B Instructor Under Training (IUT) enrolled in the IUT curriculum up through the Q4204 NATOPS flight event. In the unlikely event that performance is unsatisfactory and remediation would lead to an excessive time to train, Commander, Training Air Wing FIVE shall notify the TPS Chief Flight Instructor for further direction.

8. <u>Prerequisites</u>. Prerequisites shall be IAW reference (a), except as displayed on the flowchart, enclosure (1).
