Williams Chosen as Department December Employee of the Month

Jami Williams has been selected as the Missouri Department of Corrections Employee of the Month for December 2009. Williams is employed as an Investigator I with the Intelligence and Professional Standards Unit of the Office of the Inspector General. She works at Boonville Correctional Center in Boonville, Missouri. Williams is being recognized for going above and beyond her normal working duties.

In a letter to Williams, Missouri Department of Corrections Director George A. Lombardi wrote, "In recent months you have displayed an exemplary level of skill and tenacity in gathering intelligence effecting the safety and security of several institutions.
