COMMAND MISSION

FACSFAC San Diego provides off-shore air traffic control and surveillance as well as active management of assigned airspace, operating areas, ranges, and training resources to promote the combat readiness of U.S. Forces and support homeland defense.

FACSFAC San Diego will:

- Maintain a 24/7 watch facility that provides air and surface control and coordination to users within our AOR with an emphasis on safety, efficiency, and professionalism.
- 2. Take care of our service members, government civilians, and contractors.
- Ensure our three detachments (Pearl Harbor, San Clemente Island (SCI), and Southern California Offshore Range (SCORE)) are well supported so they can accomplish their missions.
- Oversee the SOCAL and NOCAL range complex sustainment (RCS) program to facilitate the preservation of our range assets and future range investments.
- Function as the model manager for the Data Collection and Scheduling Tool (DCAST) program while leading its development and implementation throughout the Fleet.
- Serve as the Navy's Regional Airspace Coordinator (RAC) for the Western Service Area of the U.S.
- 7. Manage contracted air services (CAS) for the Pacific AOR.
