Phases of an Inspection

- 1. Preparation Phase
- 2. Execution Phase
- 3. Completion Phase

Preparation Phase

- Research
- Gather Information
- Identify "high payoff" items
- Develop the Inspection Concept
- Inspection Team Make-up
- Train-up

Execution Phase

- Inbrief
- Meet guides and points of contact Inbrief
- Gather information
 - Observation
 - Interviewing
 - Reviewing Documentation
- Crosswalk
- Analyze the results

Completion Phase

"It ain't over till' the paperworks done!"

- Prepare your information for the outbrief
- Keep everything professional and above board
- Someone should be the "stuckee"
- Turn your findings in on time

Five elements to inspecting

- 1. Compliance
- 2. Magnitude of the Problem
- 3. Seeking the Root Cause
- 4. Determine the Solution
- 5. Assign Responsibility
