The Supreme Court hereby issues an invitation to all interested persons to file an application for permission to file a brief as amicus curiae in SC 18793, *Mary H. Kortner, Administratrix (Estate of Caroline Kendall Kortner) v. Craig L. Martise.* The amicus curiae brief should focus on the following question:

"When the Probate Court has ordered a conservatorship of the person only and has not expressly granted authority to the conservator to sue on behalf of the conserved person, does the conservator have standing to commence an action in the conservator's own name in her capacity as conservator for intentional torts against the conserved person by a third party?

The matter was argued before the Supreme Court on March 13, 2013. The case <u>summary</u> and <u>case information</u> are available on the Judicial Branch's website.
