
The nursing workforce survey was developed by the National Council of State Boards of Nursing (NCSBN) in conjunction with the Board. The questions, taken from the Minimum Nurse Supply Dataset, are designed to pro-

With that in mind, the Board asked the Board's Advisory Group on Nursing Education to examine various options for nurses' continued education to achieve a BSN degree.

vide a snapshot of the nursing workforce in Ohio. NCSBN and the Forum of State Nursing Workforce Centers are working together in a joint effort to collect nursing workforce supply data with the goal of creating a national picture of nursing workforce information for use in development of health care policy. Ohio's data will contribute to that national picture.

"Recommendation 4: Increase the proportion of nurses with a baccalaureate degree to 80 percent by 2020. Academic nurse leaders across all schools of nursing should work together to increase the proportion of nurses with a baccalaureate degree from 50 to 80 percent by 2020. These leaders should partner with education accrediting bodies, private and public funders, and employers to ensure funding, monitor progress,

and increase the diversity of students to create a workforce prepared to meet the demands of diverse populations across the lifespan."

The Board is represented on the newly formed Aging and Higher Education Advisory Committee convened by representatives of the Ohio Department of Aging and the Ohio Board of Regents to address how Ohio trains and supplies the needed workforce, among other issues. The Committee is beginning its work, and their discussions may include articulation, transfer agreements, and credit for life/work experience.

The Board strongly supports and encourages higher education levels for nurses, and has observed that nursing education programs continue to increase their capacity to educate nurses at the BSN level, and increase articulation of nurses' coursework between programs, to provide greater educational access to nurses seeking to continue their education.



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Registered Nurse Performance of Patient Health History and Physical Examination

At its July 2011 meeting, the Board of Nursing approved a new Interpretive Guideline (IG) that addresses the performance of a health history and physical examination by a registered nurse. The IG "Registered Nurse Performance of a Patient Health History and Physical Examination for Purposes of Providing Nursing Care" discusses the scope of practice for registered nurses that may include the performance of a health history and physical examination when the purpose of the history and physical examination is to provide nursing care. The IG was developed in response to repeated questions from licensees concerning their role in the performance and documentation of patient health histories and physical examinations.

All of the Board's Interpretive Guidelines are available for review on the Board's website under the "nursing practice" section. Interpretive Guidelines are not a regulation of the Board, and do not carry the force and effect of law. An Interpretive Guideline is adopted by the Board as a guideline to licensees who seek to engage in safe nursing practice. Licensees may also want to review the IG companion guide "Utilizing Interpretive Guidelines." Interpretive Guidelines should be used within the context of the IG companion guide when determining the RN or LPN's individual scope of practice and the activities that the RN or LPN may perform.

The new Interpretive Guideline is as follows:

"Guidelines for Registered Nurse Performance of a Patient Health History and Physical Examination for Purposes of Providing Nursing Care."



The scope of practice for a registered nurse includes assessing health status for purposes of providing nursing care. The assessment may include the collection of a patient's health history and physical examination when the purpose of the history and physical examination is to assess the health status of an individual for the purpose of providing nursing care (section 4723.01(B) ORC).

A. A registered nurse with the necessary knowledge, skills, and ability may collect information pertaining to a patient's health history and perform a physical examination that includes but is not limited to the following:


- Interviewing the patient and others as applicable to obtain the patient's health history;
- Performing a physical examination of the patient in a systematic manner;
- Directing an LPN as applicable to collect data in accordance with the LPN's responsibilities contained in Rule 4723-4-08, OAC.
- Documenting the health history and the source of the information;
- Documenting the physical examination findings;
- Organizing and interpreting the health history and examination findings for purposes of providing nursing care;

- · Establishing nursing diagnoses resulting from the findings;
- · Executing a prepared nursing regimen and plan of care resulting from the established nursing diagnoses; and
- · Providing health counseling and health teaching appropriate for the nursing diagnoses and examination findings.
- B. When performing a history and physical examination a registered nurse should timely report to and consult with other members of the health care team, and make referrals as necessary (Rule 4723-4-03 (G), OAC).
- C. A registered nurse, who is not an advanced practice nurse, in collecting a patient's history and performing a physical examination shall not form a medical diagnosis or develop a medical regimen as this is the practice of medicine and surgery and is prohibited (Section 4723.151, ORC).

Considerations in Performing a History and Physical Examination: (Rule 4723-4-03, OAC)

- 1. The registered nurse performing a history and physical examination should maintain documentation of his/her acquisition of education and demonstrated competency, and other documentation required to ensure that practice is in compliance with written employer/institutional polices and procedures.
- 2. The registered nurse's education/ training and demonstrated competence should include, but is not limited to, the following:
 - a. Anatomy and physiology
 - b. Physical examination skills and techniques
 - c. Pharmacology
 - d. Interview techniques

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The IG "Registered Nurse Performance of a Patient Health History and Physical Examination for Purposes of Providing Nursing Care" discusses the scope of practice for registered nurses that may include the performance of a health history and physical examination when the purpose of the history and physical examination is to provide nursing care. The IG was developed in response to repeated questions from licensees concerning their role in the performance and documentation of patient health histories and physical examinations.

Accountability and Responsibility of Registered Nurses:

Section 4723.01(B) ORC, defines the scope of practice for the registered nurse. Rule 4723-4-03, OAC, holds registered nurses responsible for maintaining and demonstrating current knowledge, skills, abilities,

and competence in rendering nursing care within their scope of practice.

The registered nurse must apply the Nurse Practice Act (Chapter 4723, ORC) and rules regulating the practice of nursing (Chapters 4723-1 to 4723-27, OAC) to the specific practice setting. Further, the registered nurse must utilize good professional judgment in determining whether or not to engage in a given patient-care related activity, consistent with the law, rules, and guided by the Board's Decision-Making Model, Publication OBN-103. It is critical to note that the law and rules require that the licensee provide nursing care only in circumstances that are consistent with their education, experience, knowledge, and demonstrated competency.

Licensees should review the following:

- Section 4723.01(B), ORC
- Rule 4723-4-03, OAC
- Rule 4723-4-06, OAC
- Rule 4723-4-07, OAC

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FOLLOW-UP: Medication Administration in Private Schools



In the Spring 2011 edition of Momentum, the Board provided information related to administration of medication to students. Specifically, whether or not unlicensed individuals may administer medication to students in private schools. Ohio law authorizes unlicensed employees, if certain requirements are met, to administer medications in public schools, i.e., if designated by "the board of education of each city, local, exempted village [or] vocational school district." Section 3313.713 (B), ORC. A school that is nonpublic/private is not generally subject to Chapter 3313 of the Revised Code, and thus, this legal authorization for medication administration would not apply to private schools.

However, to clarify, if a private school or school system is chartered by the State of Ohio Department of Education, the school or system is required according to its charter agreement with the State to comply with all of the minimum operating standards set forth in the rules adopted under Chapter 3313, ORC. See 3301-35-12, OAC. By

agreeing to comply with these rules, it is the position of the Ohio Department of Education's legal counsel that Section 3313.713, ORC also applies to charter schools.

In order to determine if a private school is chartered by the State of Ohio, and thus, subject to the law regarding medication administration by unlicensed persons set forth in Section 3313.713, ORC, you may contact the Ohio Department of Education (ODE) at (877) 644-6338, or search the ODE website at: http:// education.ohio.gov, for the current list of "Non-Chartered, Non-Tax Supported Schools By County." If a school appears on the "NCNT" list, it is **not chartered**, and is **not** covered by the law authorizing unlicensed persons to administer medications in school settings.

As always, it is important to remember that Ohio law does not authorize unlicensed persons, without nursing delegation, to perform nursing services in school settings, whether public or private, other than the administration of prescribed medications in compliance with Section 3313.713, ORC.

NAME/ADDRESS CHANGES



How do I change my name with the Board?

You must submit a certified document of a name change (i.e. marriage certificate/abstract, divorce decree/dissolution, name change document) within thirty days of the change. Certified documents can be obtained from the court where the original record was filed. Photocopies or notarized copies are not acceptable for a name change. Submit your certified document with a "Name/Address Change Form" or with a brief letter which includes your Ohio license/certificate number, your previous name, your new name as you want it to appear on Board records, your

current address, county and telephone number. A Name/Address Change Form is available on the Board's website at www. nursing.ohio.gov at the "Change Your Name/Address" link. Any name change documents must be mailed to the Board. The Board will return your certified document. There is no fee for a name change.

How do I change my address with the Board?

Address changes must be submitted in writing within thirty days of the change. Submit your address change with a Name/Address Change Form or with a brief letter, which includes your name, Ohio license/certificate number, address, county and telephone number. A Name/Address Change Form is available on the Board's website at www. nursing.ohio.gov at the "Change Your Name/Address" link. If you wish to verify that your address has been changed, call the Board at (614) 466-3947 for verbal verification. There is no fee for an address change.

COMPLIANCE UPDATE: OARRS DATABASE



Amended Substitute House Bill 93, adopted by the 129th General Assembly, contains provisions intended to combat the proliferation of "pill mills" associated with drug abuse in the State of Ohio. Many articles have been publicized on this topic in statewide media in the past twelve months. For example, The Hannah Report indicated that the "Scioto County coroner found drug abuse to be a direct or indirect cause of death in about half the autop-

sies he ordered... Last year in Scioto County there were 9.8 million doses of prescription opiates dispensed... That's approximately 123 pills for every single man, woman and child that lives in Scioto County" (quoting Orman Hall) (Feb. 20, 2011).

Of direct impact to Advanced Practice Nurses with prescriptive authority are new rules, required by HB 93, that the Board of Nursing will adopt effective in 2012 regarding review of prescription records contained in the Ohio Automated RX Reporting System (OARRS) maintained by the State Board of Pharmacy. OARRS was established in 2006 as a tool to assist healthcare professionals in providing better treatment for patients with medical needs while quickly iden-

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tifying drug-seeking behaviors. An OARRS Prescription History Report can assist in assuring that a patient is getting the appropriate drug therapy and is taking their medication as prescribed.

This Rule, similar to rules being considered by the State Medical Board and other boards that regulate prescribers, will establish standards and procedures for Advanced Practice Nurses with prescriptive authority to review OARRS prior to furnishing or prescribing "reported drugs," i.e., drugs that are required to be reported to OARRS. These drugs include essentially all controlled substances (scheduled II, III, IV, and V drugs), in addition to drug products containing tramadol or carisprodol. The OARRS review will be triggered if any red flags are present, for example, the patient appears overly sedated, intoxicated or impaired during an office visit or exam.

Recently, Kentucky Governor Beshear announced that practitioners in Kentucky and Ohio will automatically be able to exchange prescription medication data with the launch of Kentucky's "Prescription Monitoring Information Exchange" (PMIX). This multistate cooperation should assist Ohio prescribers in combating the drug abuse epidemic in a costeffective manner.

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Did You Really Wash Your Hands?

As nurses, we do know the essentials of an effective infection control program (i.e. policies/procedures, surveillance/investigation, monitoring, prevention and education). However, it never hurts to remind you that the *single* most effective means for preventing healthcare acquired infections (HAIs and formerly called nosocomial infection) is proper hand hygiene.

Preventing HAIs is our professional responsibility. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention estimates 88,000 Americans per year may die of HAIs.1 HAIs not only have the personal toll of inflicting suffering and death but also have the very public cost to the United States of almost \$5 billion each year due to the extra days or weeks of hospitalization needed to treat the infection (McKibben, 2005). Patients in nursing homes and in-home care are also at risk for developing HAIs—particularly if they have invasive medical devices, such as urinary catheters or central venous catheters. Nearly 1 million infections occur annually in nursing homes.2

Would it surprise you to know more than 30 studies have shown the average rate of compliance with hand hygiene guidelines among health care workers is only 40 percent?3 A recent observational study of hand washing practices for a group of Australian doctors revealed they self-reported a 73 percent hand hygiene compliance rate. During that same observation period, the deputized nurse spies recorded the doctors' actual hand hygiene rate as 9 percent. That study demonstrated a huge discrepancy between what we believe we do versus what we actually do.4



Proper hand hygiene includes both washing with soap and water and using alcohol-based hand hygiene (ABHH) products.

- · If hands are visibly soiled, wash with soap and water using friction for at least 15 seconds. Sing "Happy Birthday" twice.
- · Wash hands with plain soap or alcohol-based product after touching blood, body fluids, and contaminated

items whether or not gloves are worn.

- Wash hands immediately after gloves are removed, between patient contacts, and when otherwise indicated.
- · Wash hands as appropriate and necessary between tasks and procedures on the same patient to prevent crosscontamination of different body sites.
- Avoid unnecessary touching of surfaces near the patient to prevent contaminating clean hands and to

prevent transmission of pathogens from contaminated hands to surfaces.

ABHH products are acceptable over soap and water when hands are not visibly soiled. Alcoholbased products have the following benefits:

- They kill the germs better.
- They leave skin in better condition.
- · They are quicker and easier to use, so people use them more.

While ABHH products are considered equal to soap and water that is only true when the product is used correctly. What is correct usage?

- Use only on dry hands.
- Use enough of the product so hands are dry again in 15 seconds, and rub hands together until they are completely dry.5

Gerberding suggests we adopt a paradigm shift in our thinking for HAIs from infections being inevitable with some being preventable to each infection being potentially preventable unless proven otherwise.6 •

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BOARD DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

- Permanent Revocation = Prohibited from ever practicing nursing or dialysis care, or working as a certified community health worker or certified medication aide.
- Indefinite Suspension = Indefinitely prohibited from practicing for a specified minimum period of time. The Board will reinstate only if all conditions for reinstatement, set at the time the action was taken, are met.
- Automatic Suspension = Suspension for a violation of a consent agreement or Board order or suspension required by law for commission of a specified felony.
- **Immediate Suspension** = Suspension required by law for a felony drug abuse offense.
- Indefinite suspension with a stay = On "probation." May practice if the license status is active but will be monitored by the Board under conditions and restrictions.
- Restrictions = Limits such as prohibition from passing narcotics or working in certain areas of practice.
- Reprimand = Least amount of discipline. Acknowledgment that what the nurse, dialysis technician or community health worker did was wrong. Does not prohibit practice.
- Voluntary surrender = May not ever practice again. Permanent action following a formal agreement by the nurse, dialysis technician, medication aide or community health worker to give up the license or certificate.
- **Fines** = A fine of up to \$500 imposed for each violation.

Below are the Board's actions taken during the last Board meetings. The actions are an accurate representation of information maintained by Ohio Board of Nursing at the time of posting. Because the name of a licensee may be the same as another, please do not assume from the name alone that a particular individual has had disciplinary action.
