## VT 14 Bridge Project Construction Update Week of October 17, 2016

Next week (October 17-21, 2016) the contractor on the VT 14 Bridge Project will continue installing a drainage culvert underneath US 2. The work will be mostly done during the evening, 6 PM to 6 AM, to minimize impacts on motorists. On Monday, there will be some short periods of alternating traffic stoppage during the day. Flaggers will assist motorists through the construction zone when travel is limited to one lane.

The contractor is boring a tunnel to install a culvert 40 feet long that is 6-8 feet below the pavement without cutting into the surface of Route 2!

Also, next Tuesday, the contractor expects to begin excavating the top five feet for the east end of a 104-foot retaining wall that will be installed near the intersection of US 2 and VT 14. The retaining wall is needed at the slope where Route 2 will be widened to add a turning lane onto VT 14.

Throughout construction the speed limit through E Montpelier village will be 25 mph.
