2017 Education Requirement Change

Pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 5094.3(c), all pending applications for CPA licensure that are not complete by December 31, 2016, will become subject to the ethics study educational requirement change on January 1, 2017. The existing 10 semester unit requirement will change to include a minimum of three semester or four quarter units in courses devoted to accounting ethics or accountants' professional responsibilities. In order to be considered complete our office must receive all outstanding documents no later than December 31, 2016.
