Hazardous Materials Operations

Logistical support expectation of the locality prior to hosting a course.

Classroom space free from external noise or interruption available to host 24 students with (adult size) classroom-type chairs and suitable tables with adequate writing surface. Smaller venues may be used as long as it does not compromise the learning environment.

Safe working environment

- (1) LCD-type projector and screen (if not available instructor may request one on loan from VDFP Division Office)
- (2) Classroom Computer dedicated to the program during the didactic portions of the course. (if not available instructor may request one on loan from VDFP Division Office)
- (1) Educational writing surface (i.e. Eraser Board, Chalk Board, Easel stand with writing pad)

Bathroom facilities

Student course materials (i.e books, manuals, study guide, research literature) cost incurred by locality or individual provider. Fourteen-day lead-time on books ordered through VDFP bookstore.

- Self Contained Breathing Apparatus and Personal Protective Equipment per student
- Appropriate tools and equipment for practical exercises as defined in Instructor outline or use of VDFP HazMat resource trailer upon request through VDFP Division Office
- Flowing body of water (i.e. creek or stream) during practical exercise modules and basic garden water hose with running water from a building or pumping apparatus
- Parking lot free from pedestrian traffic or public right away for practical skills
- Rehab rehydration for student consumption (i.e. Gatorade, water) soft drinks not recommended.

VDFP support expectations

Qualified instructor(s) with current credentials to teach the program.

Curriculum materials (Administrative Guide and PowerPoint) provided to instructor cadre' (available through Division Office) on loan or instructors/locality may purchase instructional materials through the VDFP Bookstore.
