Re: Dress Code reminder for clients and counsel

Attached is a copy of the General Order that sets out the long-standing dress code for all persons appearing in a United States Court in the Southern District of Georgia. Please provide a copy of this General Order to your clients before they appear for court. In addition, please make sure your clients understand that this dress code applies when they appear at a Section 341 meeting when that meeting is held in the federal courthouse.

Finally, we remind counsel that professional business attire is expected of you at all times, whether appearing in court, at 341 meetings, or conducting other business in the federal building.
