PSOB Review Process

- 1. PSOB Office receives initial death claim documents and assigns a claim number.
- 2. Outreach Specialist is assigned to the claim to request all basic required claim documents from the survivors and agency.
- 3. Benefits Specialist reviews the claim and supporting documents and drafts a determination recommending whether or not the claim can be approved. The claim may be sent for an independent medical review, if indicated.
- 4. PSOB Director reviews the evidence and draft determination for concurrence.
- 5. PSOB Legal Counsel reviews the evidence and draft determination for concurrence.
- 6. Once a determination is made, the survivors and agency receive written notification regarding the outcome of the claim.

*At any stage, the claim may require additional follow up to establish legal sufficiency.
