SUBJECT: Command Policy on the Use of Government Vehicles for Volunteer Service

1. References:

- a. DoD Directive 5500.7, Standards of Conduct, 30 August 1993.
- b. AR 360-1, The Army Public Affairs Program, 15 September 2000.
- c. AR 58-1, Management, Acquisition, and Use of Motor Vehicles, 10 August 2004.
- 2. Purpose: To provide guidance on the use of government vehicles in support of volunteer events.
- 3. Applicability: This policy applies to all military and Department of Defense (DoD) civilian personnel assigned, attached, located or employed on the Presidio of Monterey (POM) and Ord Military Community (OMC).
- 4. Proponent: The proponent for this policy is the Directorate of Logistics (DOL), Transportation Division, IMSW-POM-LGT at extension 7784. This policy supersedes previous policy dated 24 February 2004.
- 5. All units are required to submit a written request through the Installation Legal Office (ILO) to the Garrison Commander in order to use Army-owned/leased vehicles in support of volunteer events. The request should include, at a minimum, event title, brief description of the event, number of volunteers, number of vehicles, dates of event, and unit point of contact (POC). The Garrison Commander will approve requests on a case-by-case basis. This approval authority is not delegated to any assigned/tenant units.
