APPLICATION - EXEMPTION CERTIFICATE BUILDING MATERIALS

Who is eligible for a Building Materials Sales Tax Exemption Certificate?

- Each construction contractor or subcontractor that purchases building materials to be incorporated into real estate in an Enterprise Zone by rehabilitation, remodeling, or new construction.
- Material must be for commercial, manufacturing, or industrial construction and not for residential.

How do I apply for a Building Materials Sales Tax Exemption Certificate?

- Construction contractors or subcontractors seeking exemption certificates must go through the Clinton County Enterprise Zone Administrator. Complete this form and return by email or fax. Contact information is listed above.
- Zone Administrator will submit applications for those construction contractors or subcontractors purchasing materials to incorporate into real estate in the Enterprise Zone.
- The project for which an exemption is sought must meet the eligibility requirements set forth in the Clinton County Enterprise Zone ordinance.
- All applicants must submit end-of-year reports through the "Business Incentives Reporting and Building Materials Exemption Certification" link at the Department of Revenue's website at tax.illinois.gov/Businesses/Incentives/.
