DEFINITIONS:

<u>Mission Statement</u>: A document that defines the purpose of the organization, establishes the philosophy of the organization, and guides the setting of organizational goals and objectives.

POLICY:

- A. A mission statement encompasses the philosophy, goals, and purpose of the Department will be developed by the Secretary's Office. The mission statement shall be reviewed annually and updated as needed. [2-CO-1A-04]
- B. Each institution shall develop a written document that delineates the institutions function within the context of the total correctional system. The statement shall be reviewed annually and updated as needed. **[4-4002]**
- C. The Probation and Parole Division Region Managers and the prison wardens shall each formulate implementing objectives for each applicable managing strategy and strategic objective which translate meaningful measures. [4-4003]

- A. The Secretary of Corrections will review and, if necessary, revise the Corrections Department Mission Statement (CD-001201.A) by June 1 of each year. [2-CO-1A-04]
 - 1. The development process will include input from Division Directors, Wardens, and other appropriate management staff.
 - 2. Mission Statements will be distributed to the following areas:
 - a. All Administrative Manual Holders,
 - b. Governor's Office, and the
 - c. Chairperson, Corrections/Corrections Industries Commission.
- B. Division Directors and Wardens will develop Mission Statements and formulate goals for their respective operations and translate them into measurable objectives that comply with and carry out the departmental Mission Statement at least annually. **[4-APPFS-3D-04]**
 - 1. Upon completion these Mission Statements and goals shall be submitted to the Secretary of Corrections.
 - 2. Mission Statements and goals shall be reviewed at least annually.
