THRESHOLDS FOR THE Micro-Purchases

FAR 2.101 now defines the micropurchase threshold as \$3,000 for **supplies and services**









"Micro-purchase" means an acquisition of supplies or services using simplified acquisition procedures, the aggregate amount of which does not exceed the micro-purchase threshold.









"Micro-purchase threshold" means \$3,000, except

(1) For acquisitions of construction subject to the Davis-Bacon Act, \$2,000;

(2) For acquisitions of services subject to the Service Contract Act*, \$2,500; and

(3) For acquisitions of supplies or services that, as determined by the head of the agency, are to be used to support a contingency operation or to facilitate defense against or recovery from nuclear, biological, chemical, or radiological attack, as described in FAR 13.201(g)(1), except for construction subject to the Davis-Bacon Act









Contracts that are exempt from the Service Contracts Act (SCA) include:

1) any contract for construction, alteration, and/or repair, including painting and decorating;

2) any work required to be done in accordance with the Walsh-Healey Public Contracts Act (this Act has to do with how people are paid who play a part in the manufacture of products the cost of which will exceed \$10,000);

3. any contract for transporting freight or personnel by vessel, aircraft, bus, etc., where published tariff rates are in effect;

1. any contracts for furnishing services by radio, telephone, telegraph, or cable companies subject to the Communications Act of 1934;

2.

any contract for public utility services;

3. any employment contract providing for direct services to a federal agency by an individual or individuals;

4. any contract for operating postal contract stations for the US Postal Service;

5. any contract for installation services, maintenance services, repair services, training services, and other services if such services are procured for support of a commercial item as that term is defined in 2.101 of the FAR;

6. any contract for services of a type offered and sold competitively in substantial

quantities in the commercial marketplace based on established catalog prices for specific tasks performed under standard commercial terms and conditions; (if a service that is sold is based on an hourly rate, there must also be an established; catalog or market price established for that service);

1. any contract in which work will be done by employee exempt from the Fair Labor Standards Act (this means executives, administrative, and professional employees are exempt from the SCA); and
