## MEDIA ADVISORY: PRESIDENT BEGAYE AND VICE PRESIDENT NEZ TO SIGN ENABLING LEGISLATION ESTABLISHING A NAVAJO VETERANS ADMINISTRATION AND VETERANS ADVISORY COUNCIL

Navajo Nation President Russell Begaye and Vice President Jonathan Nez will ceremoniously sign the Navajo Veterans Act at the Twin Arrows Casino and Resort Ballroom on Saturday, Feb. 13 at 8 a.m.

After this initial signing, the president and vice president will continue through each of the five respective agencies to thank veterans and conduct symbolic signing ceremonies.

The Office of the President and Vice President invite all local and regional media to attend the signing ceremonies and welcome all media coverage.
