


"Our Navajo athletes who participated in the 2015 WNFR have set great examples of individuals leading healthy, active lifestyles. They have pushed their athleticism to compete at top levels in their sport and have come out successfully. The Begaye-Nez administration wishes to honor these athletes and recognize their talents and true potential in excelling as champions of the sport," said President Russell Begaye.

The Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association (PRCA) 2015 was exceptional for our Navajo cowboys who qualified and participated at the WNFR the past couple years. Mr. Aaron Tsinigine, Mr. Derrick Begay and Mr. Erich Rogers displayed their talent in the arena, enough to crown Mr. Aaron Tsinigine the 2015 World Champion Team Roping Header, a prestigious title and honor in modern day professional rodeo.

In 2014, Ms. Kassidy Dennison was the only Navajo female to qualify for the WNFR in the ladies barrel racing. These distinguished Navajo rodeo athletes represented the Navajo Nation with dignity and respect, which was witnessed on a national level through CBS Sports Network.

"Our Navajo people have been ranchers and horsemen for a very long time. It is inspiring to see our Navajo cowboys get well deserved recognition on the national stage during the WNFR," said Navajo Nation Vice President Jonathan Nez.

This appreciation dinner is a gesture exemplifying the Begaye-Nez Administration's support of our Navajo Professional

Rodeo Athletes. There will be dignitaries with Special Guests: Mr. Russell Begaye, President of the Navajo Nation and Mr. Jonathan Nez, Vice-President; Mr. Joe Beaver, eight-time PRCA World Champion Tie down roper.

"This is just the start. Our rodeo athletes will continue to compete in the National Finals," Vice President Nez added.

Entertainment will be provided by Miss Navajo Nation, Ms. Alyson Shirley, along with a country dance featuring Stateline.

The agenda will include a live auction as well as a meet and greet with Team Navajo comprised of the featured Navajo cowboys. However, 2015 World Champion Team Roping Header, Aaron Tsinigine will not be present as he declined the invitation to the event.

OPVP extends the invitation to the general public to attend this event honoring our champion Navajo rodeo athletes.

Tickets for the dinner will be available on a first-come, first-served basis and limited to 400. Tickets will be sold at OPVP through Friday at 4:30 p.m. Tickets will also be available in limited number at the door.

Registration for the dinner at Twin Arrows will open at 2 p.m. on Saturday, Jan. 30. Adult tickets are \$25 and children under 10 years old are \$10.
