# The Home Confinement & Location Monitoring Program

#### Handout

The Home Confinement and Location Monitoring Program Participant Agreement which you will sign when you are placed on Electronic Monitoring provides more detailed requirements of this program. Please refer to the Agreement for additional information on the conditions of your release as established by the Court

#### **Location Monitoring Program**

The condition of home confinement will be enforced by means of electronic monitoring or other specified means under the Location Monitoring Program (i.e. Voice Tracking, GPS, RF).

Defendants on Location Monitoring must adhere to all rules and regulations of home confinement.

The three components of home confinement are:

- ♦ Home Incarceration 24 hour lock downallowed out only for: court, attorney/client meetings and medical appointments.
- ♦ Home Detention Allowed out for: court, attorney/client meetings, employment, medical appointments and religious services.
- ◆ Curfew must be home from evening to morning hours as ordered by the Court.

Participants on the Location Monitoring Program must have and maintain telephone and electrical service at the defendant's expense. The services must be maintained throughout the pendency of the case or until the condition of electronic monitoring is removed.

Pre-release Conditions:

♦ Telephone must not have special features (i.e., call waiting, call

forwarding, caller ID, two way calling, voice mail, etc)

- ♦ No answering machine or voice mail
- ♦ No Cordless telephones
- No computer/modem on the unit line

### Reminder

Before retiring each evening, please be sure that the telephone and monitoring device are properly plugged in and the telephone is on the hook.

#### **Cost of Location Monitoring**

Defendants placed on Location Monitoring are expected to incur the cost of the service as determined by Pretrial Service Office.

All payments must be in the form of a **money order** and should be sent directly to the provider for electronic monitoring.

### **Employment**

Defendants who have been granted permission to seek and obtain employment by the court will only be permitted to obtain employments which are stationary (i.e., no livery cabs, delivery persons or freelance work) and must be between the hours or 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m.

Defendants permitted to obtain employment shall provide copies of pay stubs and time sheets, and are required to report their annual income to the IRS.

#### **Emergency Instructions**

An emergency is defined as:

- ♦ A fire in the residence
- ♦ Medical emergencies that require **immediate** medical care; and
- ♦ The threat of bodily harm to the defendant or other occupant of the resident

#### \*\*Notice for Attorneys\*\*

All appointments must be approved by Pretrial Services. Written notice must be received by Pretrial Services 48 hours prior to the appointment. This notification should be sent via facsimile and should indicate the date and time of the appointment as well as the approximate length of the appointment. Attorneys have the responsibility to advise PSA of cancelled appointments
