RE:	2012 Alternatives to Incarceration Annual Report

I am pleased to provide you with a copy of the 2012 Alternatives to Incarceration Annual Report for programs funded by the NYS DCJS' Office of Probation and Correctional Alternatives.

Highlights of the 2012 Reports for the various program models are as follows:

- Community Service Programs (37) report that 5,275 or 84.6% of participants successfully completed the service.
- Pretrial Services Programs (44) report 31,066 releases with an overall Failure to Appear Rate of 2.8%.
- Specialized Drug and Alcohol Service Programs (46) report 9,876 individuals placed in programs with 70.9% completing.
- Defender-Based Advocacy Programs (11) prepared 2,256 individualized clientspecific plans and 2,045 were accepted by the Courts.
- TASC Model Programs (15) report 3,481 or 81.4% successful completions.

ATI Programs continue to provide critical services to New York State's criminal justice system by providing cost-effective programs that reduce unnecessary reliance on local and state incarceration, reduce recidivism, promote public and victim safety and assist individuals change their lives to become productive residents of our State.
