Seapak Recalls Breaded Butterfly Shrimp Due to Undeclared Milk Allergen

(JUNEAU, AK) – Rich Products Corporation has issued a recall for Seapak Breaded Butterfly Shrimp because the coating of the shrimp may contain whey, a milk allergen, not declared on the product's label.

This recall is limited to 22 oz. packages of Seapak Breaded Butterfly Shrimp – Ready to Fry, with a product code of 10302, a "Best By" date of January 25, 2013 and a production date of 7/25/2011. The UPC Code is 100 41322 10254 6.

Alaska's Department of Environmental Conservation has verified this product has been distributed in Alaska.

There have been no reported allergic reactions; however, individuals concerned about a reaction should contact a health care provider.

Consumers should return this product to the retailer where it was purchased for a full refund.
