## Crown Prince Recalls Canned South Korea Shellfish

(JUNEAU, AK) – Crown Prince has issued a recall for all canned oysters originating from South Korea. This recall comes after the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) widened the alert on adulterated Korean shellfish to include canned products in addition to fresh and frozen shellfish. This recall is for oysters only from South Korea. No other Crown Prince items are affected by this recall.

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation has confirmed the distribution of the recalled products in Alaska and DEC encourages consumers to check their shelves for affected product.


No illnesses caused by the consumption of these products have been reported in Alaska or any other state.


