Safeway Lasagna Recalled for Undeclared Allergens

(JUNEAU, AK) – Windsor Quality Food Company has issued a recall for frozen Safeway lasagna products that may have been inadvertently packaged in the wrong cartons. The company discovered the problem when they received consumer complaints that the meat lasagna may have been incorrectly packaged in Safeway cheese lasagna cartons with corresponding labels that did not list egg and soy allergenic ingredients contained in the meat lasagna.

Affected products are:

- Retail cartons of "Safeway Select" Five Cheese Lasagna, Best By Date of April 4, 2013.
- Shipping cases of "Safeway Select Meat Lasagna" with a Best By Date of April 4, 2013.

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation has confirmed the distribution of the recalled products in Alaska.


No illnesses or adverse reactions have been reported in Alaska or other states. Individuals concerned about a reaction should contact a healthcare provider.


