## Ben & Jerry's Chocolate Nougat Crunch Ice Cream Recalled

No. 12-29

(JUNEAU, AK) – Unilever has issued a recall for pint containers of Ben & Jerry's Chocolate Nougat Crunch Ice Cream: Sweet Cream Ice Cream with Fudge Covered Wafer Cookies & a Chocolate Nougat Swirl ("Chocolate Nougat Crunch"). The containers are missing the allergen advisory statement, "Allergy Information: Fudge covered wafer pieces have been manufactured on shared equipment that processes peanuts and tree nuts."

People who have an allergy or severe sensitivity to peanuts or tree nuts (chestnuts, Brazil nuts, walnuts, hazelnuts, pecans, pine nuts and cashews) run the risk of serious or life-threatening allergic reaction if they consume the recalled product.

The affected product is sold in pint containers with a UPC of **7684020899** on the side, and date codes:

The date code can be found on the bottom of the pint.

DEC has confirmed these products were distributed in Alaska. To date, there have been no reports of adverse reactions or illness in any state.
