Suzanna's Kitchen Recalls Chicken Products Due to Possible Contamination from Plastic

(JUNEAU, AK) – Suzanna's Kitchen has issued a recall for chicken products that may be contaminated with pieces of plastic. The recall is a result of consumer complaints about finding pieces of plastic in the products, possibly originating from the plastic bags the products were held in prior to production.
