Sprouters Northwest Recalls Sprouts Due to Possible Listeria Contamination

(JUNEAU, AK) – Sprouters Northwest has issued a recall for packages of alfalfa, clover, brocco sandwich sprouts, and spicy sprouts due to potential contamination with Listeria monocytogenes.

Listeria monocytogenes, an organism which can cause serious and sometimes fatal infections in young children, frail or elderly people, and others with weakened immune systems. Although healthy individuals may suffer only short-term symptoms such as high fever, severe headache, stiffness, nausea, abdominal pain and diarrhea, Listeria infection can cause miscarriages and stillbirths among pregnant women.

The following products, sold under the Sprouters Northwest brand, were distributed from Jan. 10 until Jan. 18 and are packaged in plastic clamshell containers and plastic 1-pound bags:
