## Foster Farms Recalls Chicken Strips for Undeclared Wheat and Soy Allergens

No. 13-30

(JUNEAU, AK) – Foster Farms has issued a recall for ready-to-eat grilled chicken breast strips because the label does not state that the product may contain wheat and soy, known allergens. People who have an allergy or severe sensitivity to wheat or soy run the risk of serious or life-threatening allergic reaction if they consume these products.

The recalled chicken products have the establishment number "P-20923" inside the USDA mark of inspection and the Use-By Date JUN 22 2013 which is printed on each tray.
