Justin's Recalls Maple Almond Butter and Hazelnut Butter Due to Possible Metal Fragment Contamination

(JUNEAU, AK) – Justin's has recalled certain lots of Maple Almond Butter and Chocolate Hazelnut Butter because of possible presence of metallic fragments. While no metal has been found in individual jars, Justin's initiated this voluntary recall out of caution.

The affected products come in 16 oz glass jars with the "Best By" date located on the label of the jar between the UPC bar code and the nutrition facts panel.
