## Crunch Pak® Apple Slices Recalled for Possible Contamination with Listeria monocytogenes

No. 13-60

(JUNEAU, AK) – Crunch Pak® of Cashmere, Washington has issued a recall for Crunch Pak® Apple Slices possibly contaminated with Listeria monocytogenes.

Listeria monocytogenes is an organism that can cause serious and sometimes fatal infections in young children, frail or elderly people, and others with weakened immune systems. Although healthy individuals may suffer only short-term symptoms such as high fever, severe headache, stiffness, nausea, abdominal pain and diarrhea, Listeria infection can cause miscarriages and stillbirths among pregnant women.

To identify the recalled products, consumers should review both the product description or UPC code and the Best-if-Used-By-Date, printed on the back of each package.
