Tonia's Biscotti Recalled for Undeclared Allergens

(JUNEAU, AK) – Tonia's Biscotti II, LLC has issued a recall for bags of Biscotti Sampler, bags of Lemon Biscotti Dipped in White Chocolate, and individually-wrapped biscotti of all flavors because the products contain wheat, milk and soy, known allergens, that are not properly disclosed on the packages. People who have an allergy or severe sensitivity to wheat, milk, or soy run the risk of serious or life-threatening allergic reaction if they consume these products.

The recalled products were distributed at retail stores, craft fairs, and through mail order (via www.toniasbiscotti.com) within the state of Alaska. The products were last distributed December 2013. To date, no illnesses have been reported in Alaska or elsewhere.

The bagged products are packaged in a white bag with a clear view window on the front. "Tonia's Biscotti" is written on a label across the top half of the package and "Lemon Dipped in White Chocolate" or "Sampler" is written on a label on the bottom of the package. Affected bagged products can be distinguished from unaffected products because the packaging is missing a "Nutritional Facts" panel.

The individually-wrapped biscotti of all flavors are packaged in clear packaging that contains a single label on the front of the package with the name "Tonia's Biscotti" and the flavor of the biscotti.
