Little Crèmes Organic Rice Milk Snacks Recalled for Potential Choking Hazard

(JUNEAU, AK) – Plum Organics has issued a recall for its Little Crèmes organic rice milk snacks line after it was found that the product has the potential to cause choking. The small, bite-sized pieces are made to soften in a child's mouth in less than 20 seconds making them easy to swallow. Some pieces were found to take significantly longer and created a potential choking hazard for babies and young children.

The recall is for all three Little Crèmes varieties:
