**THE PHYSICIAN'S/CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGIST'S REPORT MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE COURT AT LEAST FIVE (5) DAYS BEFORE THE HEARING.** The court shall determine who is responsible for the cost of the examiner's report.

The report must include:

1. A description of the nature and degree of any current incapacity or disability, including the medical or psychological history, if reasonably available.
2. A medical prognosis or psychological evaluation specifying the estimated severity and duration of any current incapacity or disability.
3. A statement as to how or in what manner any underlying conditions of physical or mental health affects the proposed ward's ability to provide for personal needs.
4. A statement as to whether any current medication affects the demeanor of the proposed ward or the ability of the proposed ward to participate fully in any court proceeding or in any other procedure required by the court or by court rule.

5. The physician/clinical psychologist shall have access to the proposed ward's medical records, including psychiatric, mental health, psychological, and chemical dependence records.
