


## **Bryan Kinsey**

**Bryan Kinsey** is the Assistant Director of Systems and Administration in the Tennessee Comptroller's Division of Property Assessments and Office of Local Government. Bryan oversees Tennessee's Integrated Multi-Processing of Administrative and CAMA Technology (IMPACT) system, and has responsibilities related to the Property Tax Relief program, Office of Local Government GIS technology, and administrative functions including personnel and budgeting.



Bryan began his career with the Comptroller's Office in 1992. He spent 20 years working for the Division of Property Assessment's Jackson field office. During that

time he earned the Assessment Administration Specialist (AAS) designation with the International Association of Assessing Officers (IAAO) as well as the Tennessee Certified Assessor (TCA) and Tennessee Master Assessor (TMA) certifications with the State Board of Equalization. Bryan became Area Manager of the Jackson field office in 2008. Bryan was promoted to Assistant Director and relocated to the Nashville office in 2012.

Bryan holds a bachelor's degree and a Masters of Business Administration from the University of Tennessee at Martin. He is also a graduate of two of the state's premier leadership development programs: Tennessee Government Management Institute (TGMI) and LEAD Tennessee. Bryan is an active member of the IAAO, and has held several leadership roles at both the state and national level. In 2009 he was awarded the Tennessee Chapter's Ray D. Kennedy, CAE Achievement Award.
