 DHIN continues to work toward the Common Provider Scorecard




Summary of November DCHI Board meeting

Monitoring & evaluation plan

Delaware has set out a robust monitoring and evaluation strategy to test the overall success of its approach, including the effectiveness of its policy and regulatory strategy

Methodology

DCHI will pursue a structured approach to monitoring and evaluation to ensure it has insight into progress and potential risks:

Core analyses

 Comparison of progress versus goals and accountability targets

Sources of data

 Measures will primarily be collected from CDC, DPH, and payers

Translating research into practice

 DE intends to use insights to spur research & translate it into practice
