## **Transforming Clinical Practices FOAs (1/2)**

### **Opportunity**

- CMMI recently announced a new funding opportunity focused on practice transformation, the Transforming Clinical Practices Initiative (TCPI)
- Two distinct Funding Opportunity Announcements:
  - Practice Transformation Networks (PTNs) are peer-based learning networks that will recruit practices, facilitate improved practice management, and use quality measures to track progress
    - Providers are likely applicants
    - Support up to \$670M over ~35 awards
  - Support and Alignment Networks (SANs) will promote workforce development by aligning memberships and communications to support PTNs and practices
    - Professional associations among likely applicants
    - Support up to \$30M over ~30 awards
