# Update from Technical Advisory Group on provider scorecard

#### **Context**

- A common provider scorecard will aggregate quality, cost, and satisfaction metrics across payers
- Development requires the cooperation of DHIN, payers, providers, and others
- The Technical Advisory Group (TAG) has been designing solution

#### **Current design**

- In the proposed model, DHIN will:
  - Securely collect data from payers/providers
  - Aggregate above information into a scorecard per practice
  - Distribute scorecard to practices and payers
- Extensive "beta" period will begin Q2 2015 to test
- Performance period begins in 2016
